Some Examples of the Requirements



- Purchase low toxic cleaning products (Green Seal)
- Create waste stations with clear signage
- Utilize energy efficient lighting
- Install .5 gallon per minute aerators on all bathroom sinks
- Have a Commuter Benefits Program
- Inform employees about the City's Emergency Ride Home Program

Tiered Certification



There were many reasons to explore the tiered certification model...



SF Green Business Program had the most stringent standards



In 2016, 83% of businesses in the program were in our 'Office' sector



Working with businesses that were already 'Green'. 18/27 businesses in 2016 had sustainability built in their mission



Binary recognition. Businesses that completed 90% of the process were penalized while businesses had little incentives to continue the sustainability journey after certification



Other states with Green Business Programs were adopting tiered certification models
